On that auspicious day, these Rotarians met with 15 Whitby businessmen who passed a motion to organize a Rotary Club in Whitby and signified their commitment to do so.



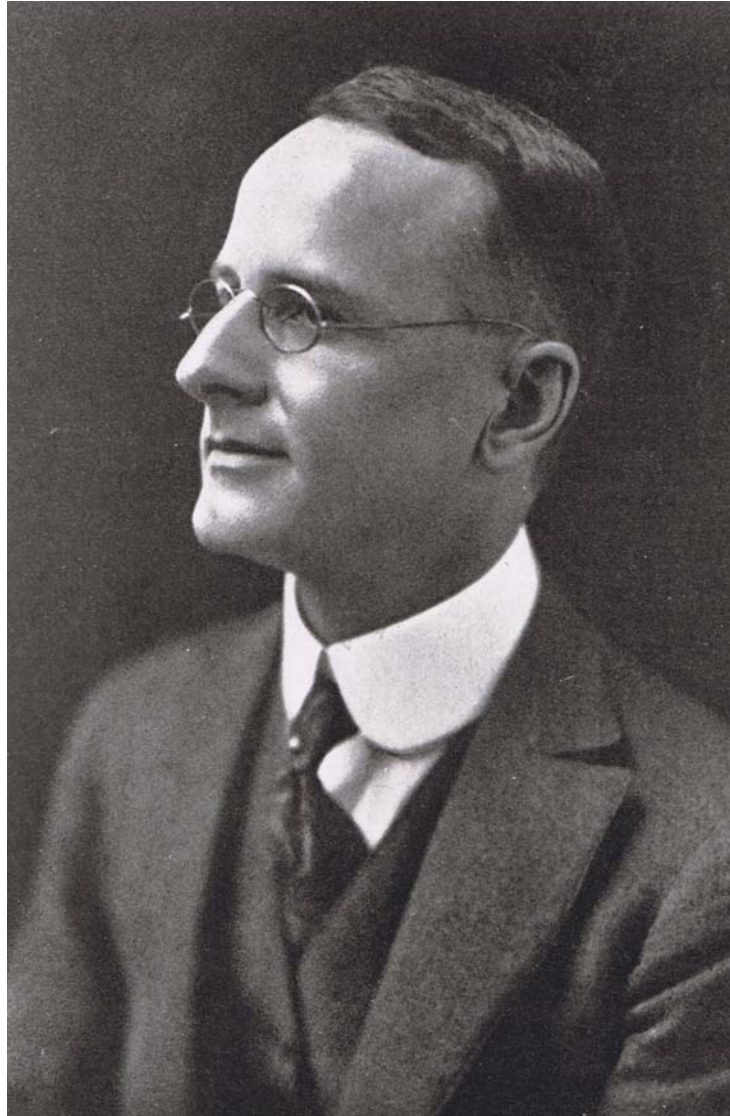
